Sharps Community Disposal Collection Service

As a service to the Community, we accept Sharps generated by the Community as a result of self maintenance programs. We accept needles, syringes, and lancets that has been disposed of in a safe container.

Sharps must be in a sharp container:

- a) Approved by the FDA or
- b) A household container that is
 1. Leak proof
 2. Shatter proof
 3. Puncture resistant
 4. Heavy-duty, rigid plastic with a screw top
 5. Clearly labeled: **SHARPS**



OR



Examples: **Laundry Detergent or Bleach bottles**

Containers NOT accepted: Glass, aluminum, metal can with flimsy lids or cardboard.

Additional Requirements:

- 1) Containers should not exceed 2/3 full. Do NOT overfill to brim of container.
- 2) NO sharps containers will be accepted from outside New York State.

Steps to Dispose of your Sharps at Rosary Hill Home:

- 1) **Call to make an appointment** (M-F, 10 am – 2pm)
- 2) On the day of your appointment, go to the main entrance (admission area). Ring the doorbell, someone will be with you to inspect the “sharps” container and give you directions to drop-off your container.
