The health of our patients is delicate. For their safety, we are following the NY Department of Health (NYSDOH) and CDC guidelines regarding visitation.

Visitation Requirements

Persons visiting in a nursing home **MUST**:

1. Wear a “surgical”-type mask (upon entry) if the Community Transmission Level is High (look up Westchester County) or they choose to continue to wear a mask based on personal preference or if they believed to be at risk for infection due to recent activities **AND**
2. Follow the Core Principles of Infection Control during their visit.

Refrain from visiting if you:

- ◆ Have tested positive for COVID-19;
- ◆ Have any COVID-19 signs or symptoms (e.g., fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea);
- ◆ Had close contact with someone with a COVID-19 infection in the prior 14 days;
- ◆ Are unable or unwilling to adhere to the Core Principles of COVID-19 Infection Control.

Core Principles of Infection Control

Any person visiting Rosary Hill Home must adhere at all times to the following Core Principles of Infection Control regardless of the place where the visits are conducted. Visitors who do not adhere to these Core Principles may be asked to leave.

1. Visitors must practice Hand Hygiene (use of alcohol-based hand rub is preferred);
2. Visitors must use face coverings (covering mouth and nose) when required;
3. Visitors must maintain social distancing from other patients;
4. Visitors must follow the instructional signage posted throughout the facility;
5. Visitors must remain in the designated visiting area (e.g., patient’s room or dayroom).
